Committee Purpose

The "Master Drainage & Flood Remediation" Project Team is seeking an Elder to provide knowledge, input and other considerations from a Traditional perspective on the history of Boston and Roger's Creek, that flow through the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation (MNCFN). This individual will provide input that is reflective of the values of the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation (MNCFN), which will assist the project team of potential risks posed to the wildlife, waterways and lands within MNCFN First Nation and contributes to the long term sustainability of the First Nation by improving the environmental, social, cultural and economic well-being of our people.

Roles and Responsibilities

The "Master Drainage & Flood Remediation" Project Team will be comprised of: Infrastructure & Development Chairs, Public Works Department, Lands, Membership & Research Department, Sustainable Economic Development Department and a Hydrologist whom will represent the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation – Chief and Council and will work in conjunction with Six Nations of the Grand River First Nation project team members in a cost share agreement to address drainage and flood remediation within the Mississaugas of the New Credit First Nation for the benefit of the MNCFN.
