Every Monday morning we start our week with an assembly at 8:45. We gather for drumming, smudge, prayer, teachings, meditation and announcements. Parents are always welcome!

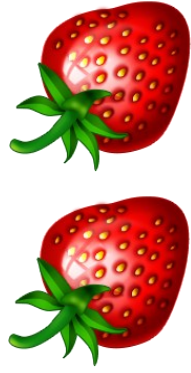
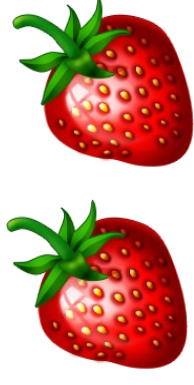
