Nihdawin Family Support Worker

Full-Time • Thunder Bay, ON

The Nihdawin Program advocates and supports Indigenous people 16+ years who are or are at imminent risk of homelessness in the community of Thunder Bay. Priority is given to Indigenous people who are at a greater risk of losing their children to the child welfare system and/or who are at a greater risk of becoming in conflict with the law because of their homelessness. The Program assists Indigenous people in these circumstances and supports their traditional roles within our culture.

Crisis Response Workers

Full-Time • Thunder Bay, ON

The Crisis Response Worker will provide 24/7 immediate response to women at risk of human trafficking or leaving a situation of trafficking, by providing immediate crisis response and stabilization with transportation to safe housing and access to supports as they require. The successful candidate will liaise with police services and will ensure ongoing trauma informed, culturally based support are provided until the woman has safely transitioned to appropriate long term supports. Crisis Response Workers will work one-on-one with at risk women and provide one-on-one counselling, cultural programming, referrals, advocacy and services.

Human Resources Assistant

Full-Time • Thunder Bay, ON

The Human Resources Assistant is responsible for supporting all portfolios throughout the ONWA. The position acts as a liaison between the HR Manager, Manager's, Directors and employees, ensuring smooth communication and prompt resolution of all queries. This role will also support daily HR activities and assist with the day-to-day operations of the HR functions and duties. The HR Assistant carries out responsibilities such as recruitment and selection including the management of the ATS, departmental development, HRIS, employee relations, training and development, benefits, compensation, organization development, employment, health and safety and executive administration.

Community Development Manager

Full-Time • Thunder Bay, ON

The Community Development Manager is responsible for the management of ONWA programs and staff within the department and oversees the delivery of the assigned programs and services. The successful candidate will lead, coach and support a group of employees within their program while ensuring ONWA's vision, mandate, objectives and client deliverables are met. This position will have an emphasis on the Indigenous Ska-Be program and will provide support services to improve the health and well being of urban Indigenous seniors and Indigenous persons with disabilities, with a particular focus on Indigenous women.
