### Job Summary:

To supervise the children in the assigned classroom in accordance with the philosophy and program statement of the Ekwaamjigenang Children's Centre. Maintain compliance with all provincial and federal legislation requirements. Ensure the safety and well being of the children under your supervision. Carry out emergent curriculum with a focus on intentional teaching and reflective practice on a daily basis. Evaluate the effectiveness of the program in terms of meeting the needs of the children in all stages of development. Maintain regular communication with parents and contribute to the effective operation of the overall childcare program while promoting and implementing practices of the Anishnabek heritage. The Registered Early Childhood Educator will adhere to the College of Early Childhood Educators Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice.

## Mandatory Requirements/Educational Qualifications

- Diploma in Early Childhood Education from an Ontario College of Applied Arts and Technology OR
- Diploma from a recognized post-secondary program recognized by the College of Early Childhood Educators **OR**
- A letter of recognition of equivalency issued by the Association of Early Childhood Educators of Ontario (AECEO).
- Practical experience in a licensed child care setting
- Must be a member in good standing with the College of Early Childhood Educators
- Must have current up to date Standard First Aid CPR/AED level "C"

### **Other Requirements**

- Must provide proof of up to date Safe Food Handlers Certification.
- A current (within 6 months) satisfactory result from a Criminal Record Check including a vulnerable sector check.
- Must provide a current Health Assessment signed by a medical doctor including up-to-date immunization with evidence of a negative result for a two step TB skin test.
