Job Summary:

The RECE will supervise the children in the assigned classroom in accordance with the philosophy and program statement of the Ekwaamjigenang Children's Centre, maintaining compliance with all provincial and federal legislation requirements.

The EarlyON Facilitator will be responsible for creating the development and delivery of inclusive and culturally responsive and appropriate learning environment that reflects effective practices; facilitating developmentally appropriate, educational, supportive and interactive programs that address unique community needs.

Both the Registered Early Childhood Educator and the Facilitator will adhere to the College of Early Childhood Educators Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice and the Child Care Early Years Act.

Mandatory Requirements/Educational Qualifications

- Diploma in Early Childhood Education from an Ontario College of Applied Arts and Technology OR
- Diploma from a recognized post-secondary program recognized by the College of Early Childhood Educators **OR**
- A letter of recognition of equivalency issued by the Association of Early Childhood Educators of Ontario (AECEO).
- Practical experience in a licensed child care setting
- Must be a member in good standing with the College of Early Childhood Educators
- Must have current up to date Standard First Aid CPR/AED level "C"

Other Requirements

- Must provide proof of up to date Safe Food Handlers Certification.
- A current (within 6 months) satisfactory result from a Criminal Record Check including a vulnerable sector check.
- Must provide a current Health Assessment signed by a medical doctor including up-to-date immunization with evidence of a negative result for a two step TB skin test.
- Facilitator requires a reliable vehicle and valid "G" driver's license
