November is now upon us and Freezing Over Moon is bringing big changes to our weather. It is important for all students to wear appropriate footwear and outerwear to keep them warm and dry. Students require separate indoor shoes. Running shoes are required fro Phys Ed.

All students are expected to be outside for active break unless rain or extreme cold prevent outdoor activity. Time outside for exercise, fresh air, and connecting to nature significantly helps students to focus and learn while in the classroom.
