All members of the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation can be nominated for an award. Current elected Council members are not eligible for nomination.

Trailblazer Award

This award recognizes an individual who has provided service to the MCFN by increasing MCFN profile or status with external communities, influencers and partners.

Eligibility Criteria

- Has made an important contribution in their career or field of work
- Has demonstrated outstanding achievement;
- Recognizes the significance of, or has developed relationships that further the vision and goals of MCFN
- Active participation in the development and delivery of programs that educate others about MCFN and our Treaty Land and Territory
- Advances the relationships of the MCFN and its members with external communities, influencers and partners.
- Has had significant and specific impact on policy,
- Has moved the Nation forward in a meaningful way
- Demonstrates the Seven Grandfather Teachings of Wisdom, Love, Respect, Bravery, Honest, Humility and Truth.

Community Volunteer Award

This award recognizes an individual who has shown outstanding generosity, resulting in service or support to MCFN through their time, actions, talents and dedication.

Eligibility Criteria

- Has worked to increase the quality of life of our Community.
- Has provided significant and continuous service to the Community or Nation
- Volunteers in community committees, groups and/or projects and has contributed to their success.
- Shares knowledge in a way that promotes health and healing in the community.
- Respects the Earth's gifts and protects the environment for future generations.
- Demonstrates integrity, generosity of spirit and collaboration
- Is a role model for young people and inspires them to volunteer
