Eligibility Criteria:

- Must reside in the Mississaugas of the Credit Community
- Must be in receipt of Social Assistance (OW, ODSP) or be considered low-income as per the Low-Income Measures Chart (see below).
- Must include income verification – i.e. pay stub, social assistance stub, bank statement, etc.
- Recipients must be having dinner in their home
- One Christmas Basket per eligible household
- Children listed in the application must reside in the home
