## Sick or Dead Birds of concern for West Nile Virus and Avian Influenza (Bird Flu)

In Southern Ontario dead crows and blue jay carcasses can be submitted for testing: Birds must be intact and reasonably fresh (not obviously rotten, no maggots or scavenging) Birds that are found on roadsides are acceptable. **Other species of dead birds accepted:** Any waterfowl (ducks, geese etc.); raptorial birds (eagles, hawks, falcons, kestrels, owls, etc.) **DO NOT HANDLE DEAD BIRDS** WITH YOUR BARE HANDS Please call MCFN Community Health: (905) 768-0141 (Mondays - Fridays) 9am-4pm to arrange for testing
