Job Summary:

The RECE Program Facilitator will develop and implement the daily kindergarten afterschool program, March Break and Summer Camp for kindergarten children and daily family and child programs in cooperation with the MCFN EarlyON Child and Family team, as well as support the licensed child care centres operated by MCFN as needed,

The RECE Program Facilitator will develop and implement culturally appropriate programming, providing support for families with infants and children up to age 6 in cooperation with the MCFN EarlyON Child and Family team. This worker will engage families and children fostering improved development of physical, intellectual, social, spiritual and emotional well-being using the six (6) components of Aboriginal Head Start: Language and Culture; Nutrition; Education; Health Promotion; Social Support and Parental and Family Involvement.
