



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Land Camp Chef/ Cook

Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN) is excited to share that we have gained a lot of student interest and we plan to move forward with offering a for-credit land camp experience this summer. In this exciting opportunity, students will be living off the land at Lloyd S. King Elementary School on June 16th to 17th and July 4th to 15th.

A critical component of the camp experience is securing an experienced chef with safe food handling certification to prepare and clean-up for meals for ~20 grade 9 and 10 students and ~5 staff each day throughout this experience. To assist with prep and clean-up, the kitchen at the MCFN community center has been secured for the land camp.

To be consistent with our land camp experience, traditional healthy foods incorporated throughout the experience are a priority. Additionally, where possible we also want to provide students with opportunities to assist with food preparation and clean-up. Finally, since gardening will be a component of the camp, we are also requesting where possible that foods that students assist with growing will also be potentially incorporated within our camps meals. Please also note that based upon the scheduled excursions (e.g. canoeing) some meals throughout the camp experience may need to be packed-up with students. Below is a summary of all the required meals based upon camp dates:

June 16th (camp dinner)

June 17th (breakfast)

July 4th to 15th will require a breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. The tentative times for each of these meals during the daily schedule are: breakfast (8:00 to 8:30 and clean-up 8:30 to 9:00), lunch (12:15 to 12:45 and clean-up 12:45 to 1:15), and dinner (5:30 to 6:00 and clean-up 6:00 to 6:30).

Throughout this experience we also intend to invite Chief and Council to attend a special dinner with students (date to be confirmed). Additionally, on two days of the camp 20 additional students are planning to join our existing students for lunch. Finally, at approximately the middle of the experience, we also intend to invite students' families to participate in a parent/ caregiver evening to connect with their students and would request that evening snacks and refreshments for students and families be provided.
