



Canada's Residential School system's legacy continues to impact survivors. Exacerbating that harm is the way in which the federal government dealt with the settlement of Indian Day School survivors.

The Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN) stands in support of thousands of other Indigenous people across Canada who are calling out the conduct of the Crown with regards to the Indian day school settlement.

The presentations and information provided to our First Nation caused confusion, and documents required by survivors proved to be daunting and as a result many settled for far less than they were entitled to. Survivors' concerns around the Day School settlement are echoed by many Indigenous people.

The approach taken during this time is inconsistent with the federal government's public position on reconciliation. What should have been an attempt to repair the damage suffered by thousands, turned out to be more of a rush to settle and release the government from any wrong doing.

We call on the federal government to act with honour and reopen the Indian Day School settlement.
