

Early Years Pedagogical Lead

Job Summary:

The Pedagogical Lead will work alongside Educators and support practices that enable them to be thoughtful and intentional about their work with young learners. They will promote deep professional and pedagogical engagement through research, reflective practice, and critical, collaborative dialogue, support Educators to reimagine Early Childhood Education as an opportunity for social and cultural responsiveness and ensure the overall implementation of all Early Learning and Child Care innovation programs are meeting the goals and standards of the framework and that the educators are consistently and deliberately striving for excellence.

Basic Mandatory Requirements:

- A Degree or Graduate Degree in Early Childhood Education or related discipline with experience of pedagogical practices;
- Must hold a Diploma in Early Childhood Education from an Ontario College of Applied Arts and Technology,
- OR a diploma from a recognized post-secondary program recognized by the College of Early Childhood Educators
- OR a letter of recognition of equivalency issued by the Association of Early Childhood Educators of Ontario (AECEO).
- Practical experience in an elementary school and/or licensed child care setting

Other Requirements

- Must be a member in good standing with the College of Early Childhood Educators
- Must have a current (within 6 months) satisfactory result from a Criminal Record Check including a vulnerable sector check.
- Must provide up-to-date immunization records, or a letter stating exemption on grounds of religion, conscience or medical recommendation.
- Must provide a current Health Assessment signed by a medical doctor.
- Must have a Safe Food Handler's Certificate, or be willing to obtain one ASAP
- Willing to complete Kindergarten Additional Qualification Courses
- Willing to travel for Professional Development and Training as required.

Hours of Work: 37.5/hrs per week

Term of Contract: Up to 3 years, with possibility of permanency
