ADULT TRANSFER POLICY

THE MISSISSAUGAS OF THE CREDIT FIRST NATION

ADULT TRANSFER POLICY

Eligibility:

All applicants must be a Status Indian, within the meaning of the Indian Act, Chapter 27, Statutes of Canada (1985), and must be registered with a First Nation in Canada.

Application:

- 1. All applicants must complete an Adult Transfer Request and submit to the Lands & Membership Department prior to submission to the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation Council for approval.
- 2. Each adult (over the age of 18 years) must complete their own application. If by reason of illness, disability or other cause, a guardian of that person may submit an application on his/her behalf. Copy of Power of Attorney or guardianship document is required.
- 3. Provide a copy of a long form birth certificate which confirms family relationship to Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.
- 4. Provide a copy of current Certificate of Indian Status Card or Secure Certificate of Indian Status card.
- 5. Provide a Criminal Record Check (CRC), completed with in the preceding 3 months.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The Applicant must have at least one parent who was registered at the time of their death or is currently registered with the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.
- 2. Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation will accept transfer requests to Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation, on the following conditions:
 - a. All applicants must submit a consent to conduct an internal credit check, to determine if the person owes an outstanding debt to MCFN.
 - b. All applicants must submit a consent, authorization and direction to their existing First Nation directing them to advise if the applicant has any debts owing to their existing First Nation.
 - c. Applicants may be denied education and housing funding if they have exhausted all funding from their existing First Nation.
- 3. Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation will accept former members who were involuntarily transferred due to marriage to another First Nation member.
- 4. Complete applications will be presented to MCFN council every 3 months.
