MINOR TRANSFER POLICY

THE MISSISSAUGAS OF THE CREDIT FIRST NATION

MINOR TRANSFER POLICY

Eligibility:

All minors must be a Status Indian, within the meaning of the Indian Act, Chapter 27, Statutes of Canada (1985), and must be registered with a First Nation in Canada.

Application:

- 1. Parents or guardians must complete a Minor Transfer Policy application and submit to the Lands & Membership Department for verification of completed requirements prior to submission to the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation Council for approval.
- 2. Both parents or guardians must sign the application. If only one parent or guardian is signing the application, they must attach a copy of the most recent custody order.
- 3. Provide a copy of a long form birth certificate which confirms family relationship to Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.
- 4. Provide a copy of the minor(s) current Certificate of Indian Status Card or Secure Certificate of Indian Status card. Along with a copy of the MCFN parent Certificate of Indian Status Card or Secure Certificate of Indian Status card.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The minor must have at least one parent who was registered at the time of their death or is currently registered with the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.
- 2. Complete applications will be presented to MCFN council every 3 months.
