#### **JOB SUMMARY**

Responsible for providing support to the community by identifying individuals who are in a high-risk situation or expressing early signs and symptoms; providing individual/group counselling and wellness planning for youth and adults with addictions; providing education, presentations and information sessions on addictions.

### **Mandatory Requirements/Educational Qualifications**

- University degree in Social Work with a minimum of three years of work-related experience
- College diploma in Addictions/Social Work with a minimum of four years of work-related experience

#### **Knowledge/Skills/Abilities/Assets**

- Knowledge of drug and alcohol service delivery
- Knowledge of concurrent disorders
- Extensive knowledge of therapeutic intervention and of the range of evidence-based treatment modalities in addictions
- Knowledge of MCFN culture and social structure
- Familiarity with traditional approaches to helping and healing
- Ability to record and report case notes within the legislative timeframes
- Ability to relate effectively to community members
- Good oral and written communication skills
- Solid understanding of computers with specific knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel
- Certification as an Addictions Counsellor/Specialist from the Canadian Certification Board

- Must have a satisfactory result from a Criminal Record Check including a vulnerable sector check
- Certification in First Aid and CPR or willingness to obtain by the end of the probationary period
