# MCFN Graduation Award Program



# <u>Goal</u>

The Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN) graduation award program began in 2005 and provides MCFN students with awards for their academic achievements.

# Preamble

The MCFN Department of Lifelong, in partnership with the MNCFN Community Trust, has provided the Graduation Award Program for the student members of the First Nation. The program provides monetary awards based on the level of education the student completes. From elementary to post-secondary, all are rewarded from their graduation.

## **Eligibility**

The award program is open to all MCFN members regardless of residency. All members who attend and graduate from an educational institute are eligible for a onetime per educational level award. Awards will only be given for current graduation from the Educational Institute. No monetary awards will be given for previous years which were not applied for.

### **Procedures**

- 1. Awards will be processed once the annual funding application has been approved by the MNCFN Community Trust.
- 2. Applications for the January to December calendar year will be accepted until March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year.
- 3. Submit proof of confirmation of graduation, such as official transcript, letter from faculty or copy of your diploma.
- 4. Submit a photocopy of status card.
- 5. If a copy of your diploma was not submitted as proof of graduation such is requested to be submitted for our records.



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
