



Call for Applications: MCFN Community Trust – Appointed Trustee Positions

Two-Year Term: January 1st, 2026 – December 31st, 2027

The Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation Chief and Council are inviting applications for three Appointed Trustee positions on the MCFN Community Trust. These appointments are made every two years in accordance with Section 5 of the Trust Agreement.

The following positions are open for appointment:

- Youth Delegate (1 position)
- Legal Delegate (1 position)
- Financial Delegate (1 position)

Youth Delegate – Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Be a Member of the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation
- Be 18 to 29 years of age at the time of appointment
- Hold an Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent
- Reside on the MCFN Reserve

Youth applicants must provide documentation confirming all eligibility criteria.

Legal Delegate – Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Work in the legal profession and hold a valid law license
- Do not need to be an MCFN Member
- Do not need to reside on the MCFN Reserve

Financial Delegate – Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Work in the financial sector, such as banking, investment, or finance
- Do not need to be an MCFN Member
- Do not need to reside on the MCFN Reserve

About the Appointed Trustee Roles

Appointed Trustees serve a two-year term. Legal and Financial Delegates are expected to have the professional education and experience appropriate to their fields. The Trust maintains a priority of ensuring strong on-reserve representation among its Trustees.
