Road Closure Information & Conditions

Full Road Closures: No access will be available at the jobsite location for through traffic. This includes local traffic and Emergency Services.

Requirements

- Traffic control must be setup in accordance with OTM Book 7.
- Official detour signage must be setup for any Road closure lasting longer than 12 hours
- Detours lasting longer than 12 hours - mapping must be submitted with the Road Closure Application for approval
- Garbage / Recycling must be considered and incorporated into detour. Services to residents must not be affected during road closures. The Contractor is responsible for ensuring waste materials/receptacles are taken to a common collection point (generally nearest intersection) before 8am on collection days and empty receptacles are returned to the correct properties within 24 hours of collection days. This should be communicated to the Garbage & Recycling Contractor.
- Application must be received 3 business days before planned Road Closure.
- The area within the road closure shall be a construction zone to be fully maintained (i.e dust, potholes, signs, etc..) by the Contractor during the road closure
- Changes due to weather - the form must be cancelled as soon as possible, and re-submitted with updated dates / times
- Road closures that are extended beyond the timeframes noted on the form - The form must be updated and sent to all agencies - at least 30 minutes prior to the time identified on the form.
- Road closures that end earlier than timeframes noted on the form - The OPP & EMS must be notified if the completion is more than 1 hour earlier than identified on the form.
- Applicant/contractor must fax/email approved form to all relevant agencies.

Partial Road Closures: Road closures to minimize traffic on larger construction projects. Through traffic is available for local traffic, County Services and Emergency Services. Approved on site by site basis.

Requirements

- Traffic control must be setup in accordance with OTM Book 7. Signage must identify that local traffic only have access - proceed with caution.
- The area within the road closure shall be a construction zone to be fully maintained (i.e dust, potholes, signs, etc..) by the Contractor during the road closure
- Changes due to weather - the form must be cancelled as soon as possible, and re-submitted with updated dates / times
- Road closures that are extended beyond the timeframes noted on the form - The form must be updated and sent to all agencies - at least 30 minutes prior to the time identified on the form.
- Road closures that end earlier than timeframes noted on the form - The OPP & EMS must be notified if the completion is more than 1 hour earlier than identified on the form.
- Application must be received 3 business days before planned Road Closure.
- Applicant/contractor must fax/email approved form to all relevant agencies.

Emergency Road Closures In a case of an emergency road closure, EMS, OPP and Roads Operations must be notified immediately for safety reasons. The agency doing the Road Closure is still responsible for completing and faxing/emailing the Road Closure Form to all agencies as soon as practical.
