

Niagara Reinforcement Limited Partnership (NRLP)

Bursary Program – 2026

Program Overview

The Niagara Reinforcement Limited Partnership (NRLP) is a collaborative initiative between Hydro One Networks, the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation (MCFN), and Six Nations of the Grand River. This partnership strengthens economic development opportunities in Ontario and provides long-term benefits to participating communities.

To support and encourage the educational goals of community youth, NRLP has established an annual bursary program. In its 4th year (2026), three bursaries will be awarded by the MCFN Lifelong Learning Department, all three for **new post-secondary students**.

Award Amount

- Three bursaries of \$750 each for MCFN students

Eligibility Criteria

- Demonstrate academic perseverance and resiliency.
- Reside either on or off the Territory.
- Be enrolled in a post-secondary institution for the upcoming Fall semester.
- Provide a one-page letter describing your educational journey and goals, and how one of the Seven Grandfather Teachings relates to your experience.
- Optional: Include supporting documentation (e.g., citizenship awards, volunteer confirmations).
- Consent to the use of your name and photo for publication on the NRLP website.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by staff of the MCFN Lifelong Learning Department, based on the eligibility criteria and verification of active registration with the department. Applications will **open April 1, 2026** and will **close August 31, 2026**.

Notification Timeline

Successful applicants will be invited to the Annual Awards Dinner on November 14, 2026 and are encouraged to attend the bursary presentation in person with supportive guests.
