

THREE FIRES HOMECOMING POW WOW AND TRADITIONAL GATHERING  
**VENDOR POLICIES**



- FOOD VENDORS BY INVITATION ONLY
- Only TWO bracelets per vendor will be provided - all others must pay admission at the gate every day.
- Vendors must always wear bracelets/avail when asked.
- Vendor Parking will be located at 468 New Credit Road, only one vehicle per booth is permitted, and Food Vendors have priority.
- Overflow parking for vendors will be in the regular event parking lot located at 2789 Mississauga Road.
- Food Vendors will provide a copy of the SFHC.
  - All helpers must be certified with their safe food handler's certification.
  - Bring materials that can be recycled or composted. IE food containers, cups, utensils, grease containers (do not empty on the grounds)
  - If you plan to sell food on Friday Night Entertainment night, please plan accordingly.

**SATURDAY SET-UP:**

8 - 10 a.m.

All vehicles out of pow wow grounds by 10 a.m.

- If you choose to store any goods on site, the Pow wow committee will not be responsible for damage or theft.
- All vendors are responsible for bringing their own tables, chairs, canopy, and protective rain gear.
- MCFN will not be responsible for any personal injury or damage or theft or loss of equipment, goods, or products of the vendor.
- Report to the vendor coordinator, under the registration tent, upon arrival at the powwow grounds. to receive booth numbers, vendor package, and instructions.

- ALCOHOL / DRUG FREE EVENT
- No pets allowed (papers must be given to Cultural Committee if therapy animal)

**If the vendor does not follow any of the policies and procedures outlined in the Vendor Booth Policies and Procedures document, the Cultural Committee reserves the right to dismiss a vendor from future powwow participation as a vendor, with no refund provided.**
