AGENDA ITEM NO. 5 – HUMBER RIVER PERSONHOOD (EF)

Councillor Erma Ferrell shared a letter that was sent to specific political organizations in 2024, to obtain support to apply for personhood for the Humber River.

The Humber River Calling was formed to celebrate and heal the Humber River watershed. In 2023, Councillor Erma Ferrell presented a briefing note to MCFN Chief and Council to support the Humber River Calling members to request "personhood" for the Humber River. Personhood", means in a court of law the Humber River will have the same rights as a person.

At this time, Councillor Erma Ferrell was requesting a new letter containing the same information requesting personhood to be signed by Chief Maragret Sault.

Council had a discussion on this issue and decided that wording needed to be changed to strengthen the letter. The Council asked if Councillor Erma Ferrell could work with Chief Margaret Sault and enrich the letter.

DIRECTION NO. 1

That the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation Regular Council directs Councillor Erma Ferrell to work with Chief Margaret Sault to change the letter going to the Humber River Personhood with more information and some wording changed.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 6- EMT AND OTHER ITEMS

A. FIFA UPDATE

Councillor Jai King-Green brought an update from FIFA and asked if the working group of FIFA could utilize the MCFN administration credit card to cover the \$600.00 (six hundred dollars) per room, for fourteen rooms, total would be \$8400.00 (eight thousand dollars) at the Royal York Fairmount Hotel Toronto.

Councillor Jai King-Green also stated that FIFA Canada 2026 has booked and paid for twenty rooms at the Fairmont Royal York Toronto for all twenty drummers participating in the opening ceremonies. FIFA Canada is asking if we can utilize the MCFN credit card account to cover the credit card authorization at \$600.00 (six hundred dollars) of the fourteen rooms at a hold of \$8,400.00 (eight thousand dollars). Six of these twenty rooms Musqueam Indian Band, the Squamish Nation, and the Tsleil-Waututh Nation who are the host First Nations for FIFA Vancouver 2026 will be covered.

Council approved using the Admin. Department Credit Card for this hold on the rooms.
