9A) – PROPOSED HERITAGE DESIGNATION OF 1725 MISSISSAUGA RD.DOCA-(MD)

This agenda item was brought to the attention of the Director of DOCA, Megan DeVries. This is a Heritage Designation and the City of Mississauga would like a support letter from MCFN.
